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Just when you think <u>Best Jordans Shoes</u> would be done pumping out new colorways of the Nike Air More Uptempo, you were wrong. Nike is prepared to release a pair that honors what most people would consider Scottie Pippen's biggest rival as a member of the Chicago Bulls. This shoe features a white leather upper with royal blue and orange accents including the "AIR" branding on the side panel of the shoe. This shoe also honors either the Knicks legendary Center Patrick Ewing or Scottie Pippen or both with an embroidered "33" on the heel in orange. The shoe is finished off with white laces and an orange visible air unit.

While the <u>Jordan 4 For Sale</u> was originally slated for a Sept. 1 release date on 43einhalb, because it was taken down, that may be in question now. However it appears as though we will have more than one release in this collection. Stick with Sneakerwatch for more news on this and other releases. The "Desert Ochre" Colorway released earlier this year as a Women's only release and quickly sold out. With this pair, the shoe utilizes the same tannish tumbled leather upper, but also features a bright orange for the ballistic mesh part of the upper. This pair doesn't' appear to have the Duffle Bag either.

Today we have the first look at yet another Heiress <u>Cheap Curry 4</u> releasing this year but in a camouflage colorway. The Retro of choice by way of the Air Jordan 5. It features a premium camo upper with gold accents seen along the stitching and midsole. The shoe could possibly be one of an entire collection, similar to how images of the last collection unveiled intermittently. This colorway of the Air Jordan 5 is expected to hit retailers September 16th, giving Jordan Brand plenty of time to unravel more Retros for a possible second "Heiress" pack. The retail price for the Air Jordan 5 PRM Heiress Camo is set at \$160.
