The sneaker we've been teasing for months finally has a release date and official images provided by the good brothers and sisters of Jordan Brand. Take a look at these joints for yourself in the pics provided above. This wonderfully executed rendition of the [Buty Jordan Sklep](#) features a 'Game Royal' suede paneled base complete with matching synthetic netting complete with a 'Metallic Silver' 3M reflective tongue, black Jumpman embroidery that hits the tongue and heel of the kicks, clear lacelocks that center the sneaker, black midsole shark's teeth, a visible AIR unit installation, and a partially icy translucent outsole to round out the kicks.

When it comes to Jordan products in college, [Cheap Air Max](#) few have the arsenal like Georgetown, University of Oregon and UNC. A few weeks ago we saw a Jordan 6 for the championship UNC team last year and now thanks to UNC forward Shea Rush, we have a preview of the latest silo in UNC colors. Showing off the high and low top versions of the 32, both utilize the Uni Blue and White color palette with UNC branding on the tongue. It's uncertain at this time if the shoes will see release, but the 31 Low PE did drop, so one may release before the season ends.
