

At the [Best Jordans Shoes](#) unveiling this past weekend, the Doernbecher Freestyle '17 collection was unveiled, as well as special pairs that were auctioned off. Arguably the two most popular shoes in the pack: the Jordan 12 and the Air Max More Uptempo, received alt. versions of the pairs that will go to retail and help raised over \$50k for OSHU Doernbecher.

Carissa Navarro, who designed the [Latest Jordans Shoes](#), created a version based on her twin sister Savannah (Carissa was born without Kidneys, and Savannah kept her alive in the womb until she could begin dialysis). Utilizing a Black and Royal Blue color scheme, Carissa also replaced her pizza lace locks with pugs.

Brody Miller, who designed the [Cheap Jordan Shoes](#) More Uptempo, designed his alt. pair for his neurosurgeon, Dr. Lissa Baird. Calling her his Wonder Woman (and keeping in tact with his fictional Generator Man alter ego), the shoe utilizes a Red upper with stars on the sock liner, as well as the Wonder Woman Logo with Lissa Baird's initials on the tongue. As they are auction exclusive, they won't release to the public, but you can check them out above in anticipation for the pack to drop on Nov. 18.
